Broadwell conducted hundreds of hours of interviews with General Petraeus, had extensive access to his mentors, his subordinates, and his longtime friends, and was granted exclusive access to his career archive. With more than a decade of military service under her belt and nearly two decades of work in counterterrorism and counterinsurgency, Broadwell embedded with the general, his headquarters staff, and his soldiers on the front lines of fighting and at the strategic command in Afghanistan to chronicle the experiences and education of this American general and to provide an unprecedented examination of his command in Afghanistan.

Telling the inside story of Petraeus’s development and leadership in war from every vantage point, **ALL IN** examines his evolution as a soldier from his education at West Point in the wake of Vietnam to his earlier service in Central America, Haiti, Kuwait, Bosnia, and Iraq. Broadwell also documents, as never before, the general’s role in the war in Washington, going behind the scenes of negotiations during policy reviews of Afghanistan in Congress, the Pentagon, and the White House.
